### The application:

All applications should be submitted in English including translation of qualifications and certificates which must be certified. There is a requirement for details of the applicant's physiotherapy education to be confirmed by the Director of the Physiotherapy Establishment.

### Further requirements:

The Irish Association has no automatic recognition of physiotherapy qualifications from any other country. European law states that should a significant shortfall be identified the applicant must be offered the option of aptitude test or adaptation period. To date, there have been no requests for aptitude tests from migrant physiotherapists. Adaptation periods have been undertaken by applicants in the areas of clinical practice where the shortfall has been identified. Knowledge of English is desirable.
