### Competent Authority:

The “**Norwegian Registration Authority for Health Personnel (SAFH)**” in Norway is the Competent Authority for the migrant physiotherapists application.

### The application:

The applicant should submit evidence of an accepted physiotherapy education and national authorisation from the applicant's member state. There must be confirmation of an offer of employment in Norway, and the employer may request a language test. Evidence of good conduct is also required.

- Evidence of physiotherapy qualification (with diploma)
- Evidence of good conduct
- Curriculum Vitae
- Documentation of applicant's name, date of birth and nationality (e.g. copies of relevant pages from passport).
- Confirmation by the applicants
- Name of Competent or other National Authority

### Further requirements:

The Norwegian association has automatic recognition of migrants from other EU (European Union) countries. However, an adaptation period of 9 months is required for German migrant physiotherapists. Aptitude tests are generally not required but the association reserves the right to prove each case individually.



## **MIGRATION INFORMATION NORWAY**

Knowledge of the host country's language is desirable and must in some cases be achieved. The migrant applicant must be an authorised physiotherapist in Norway to become a member of the association.
